





- Van retrofits and components















WHERE DOES RPL GO!


- Primary Focus- Expand Services in NW Rochester

 - Festival support (Lilac Festival + Jazz Fest)







Rochester Public Library's new mobile library holds rolling carts of library materials, programming supplies, and portable technology so our staff can take the library experience on the road.

RPL GO! offers convenient library access to hard-to-reach areas in the City of Rochester. Its home base is the Lyell Branch Library, which serves as RPL's first hybrid branch, combining traditional onsite and mobile library services.
